

Day 00: Delhi - Shimla

- Meet at the boarding point in Delhi.
- Start your overnight journey from Delhi to Shimla in AC Bus.

Day 01: Shimla - Chitkul/Sangla

- This morning we will reach **Shimla** and the Adventure begins.
- Hit the roads and begin your transfer from Shimla to Chitkul.
- Travel along the Sutlej River till Karcham from where you will take a right turn towards Chitkul following the Baspa river.
- Chitkul is the last inhabited village before the Indo-China border.
- Overnight stay and dinner in Chitkul/Sangla

Note: We'll stay in Sangla if the harsh weather doesn't allow us to stay in Chitkul.

Day 02: Chitkul - Nako/Tabo

- Early call by the Trip Captain.
- Depart to Tabo & On your way we'll take hault at Khab Sangam.
- Reach Nako & visit the Nako Lake, have your lunch.
- Reach Nako/Tabo & Enjoy your food & stay in Homestay.

Note: The stay can be either in Nako or in Tabo

Day 03: Tabo-Kaza via Dhankar

- Wake up early & go to Tabo Caves.
- Have your Breakfast & visit Tabo Monastery.
- Depart for Kaza.
- Visit Dhankar Monastery on the way to Kaza.
- Reach Kaza by evening & check into your homestay.
- Enjoy the local food & afterwards watch the Stars.









Day 04: Kaza-Langza-Hikkim-Komic

- Visit Langza, here is the popular 35ft. Buddha Statue at an altitude of 4400 mts.
- Next on the list is Komic- the highest village connected with a motorable road.
- Afterwards visit the Highest Post Office in the world. At night do stargazing & witness the milkway galaxy.
- · Stay in a cozy homestay & enjoy the food.

Day 05: Kaza-Key-Chicham-Kibber

- Visit the Asia's highest Suspension Bridge- Chicham Bridge.
- Afterwards go to Kibber, have your lunch here.
- Next is the heart of Spiti- Key Monastery.
- Come back to Kaza & explore the market.
- Overnight stay in Kaza.

Day 06: Kaza-Kalpa

- Have your breakfast & check out from the homestay.
- Drive to explore Gue Monastery. (500 Years Old Mummy), If time permits
- Depart for Kalpa.
- Reach Kalpa by evening.
- Check into your camps/hotel have your dinner & rest.

Day 07: Kalpa-Shimla-Delhi

- Early morning breakfast & leave for Shimla.
- Enjoy your time at Suicide Point.
- Reach Shimla by evening.
- Now it's time to say goodbyes to the mountains & return to Delhi with a heart of full of memories.
- Back to Delhi, overnight journey.

Day 08: Reach Delhi by morning

- · Reach Delhi by morning.
- Trip Ends with full of unforgettable memories.



Reasons To Visit Spiti With Us





























- NO REFUND SHALL BE MADE WITH RESPECT TO THE INITIAL BOOKING AMOUNT FOR ANY OF THE CANCELLATIONS. HOWEVER,
- If cancellations are made 30 days before the start date of the trip, 50% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made 15-30 days before the start date of the trip, 75% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- If cancellations are made within 0-15 days before the start date of the trip,
 100% of the trip cost will be charged as cancellation fees.
- In the case of unforeseen weather conditions or government restrictions, certain activities may be canceled and in such cases, the operator will try his best to provide an alternate feasible activity. However, no refund will be provided for the same.



1. Respect is Non-Negotiable

Respect fellow travellers and the trip leader at all times. Any misconduct or disrespect may result in immediate removal from the trip without a refund.

2. Activity Participation at Own Risk

All activities are undertaken at the traveller's own risk. Disclosure of any preexisting medical conditions is mandatory before the trip.

3. Alcohol Consumption

Alcohol may be consumed at the traveller's own discretion. The Trip Captain is not responsible for any consequences arising from your actions under its influence.

4. Damage Responsibility

Any damage to public or hotel property caused by a traveller will be the sole financial responsibility of that individual.

5. Punctuality is Key

If a traveller is not on time for scheduled activities or tours, the trip will proceed without them. The trip leader will not be responsible for delays caused by individuals.





1. Content Rights

All photos and videos captured during the trip are the sole property of Nomads Travel Club and Trip with Nomads. Unauthorized use or distribution by any third party is strictly prohibited.

2. Booking & Payment Policy

Full payment is required no later than 30 days before the trip. Failure to complete the payment after two follow-ups may result in cancellation. A valid government-issued ID is mandatory for boarding. Bookings are non-transferable.

3. Passport & Visa Requirements

Your passport must have a minimum validity of 6 months. We do not take responsibility for visa refusals, delays, or deportation for any reason.

4. Cancellation & Refund Policy

No refunds will be issued for unused services. We are not liable for any loss or damage to personal belongings during the trip.

5. Trip Timings & Travel Conditions

Departure timings are fixed and must be adhered to. Use of air-conditioning during travel is subject to the driver's judgment for safety reasons.

6. Health, Safety & Conduct

Consumption of alcohol or smoking in transport vehicles is not permitted. All participants should be in good physical health. We are not responsible for any injury, illness, or lost items during the trip.

7. Code of Conduct

Inappropriate behavior may lead to removal from the trip at the participant's expense. Participants must cooperate with the trip coordinators at all times.

8. Force Majeure & Emergencies

We are not liable for delays, disruptions, or alterations caused by weather, political events, or emergencies. Any expenses for emergency transport or evacuation due to illness or injury must be covered by the participant.

- **9.** The time of Departure is stated & fixed. All travelers must update their status with the Trip coordinator(s), & report at the pickup point 30 mins prior to the scheduled departure.
- **10.** Numerous factors such as weather and road conditions the physical the ability of participants etc. may bring alteration in the itinerary. We reserve the right to make necessary changes in the schedule in the interest of safety, comfort and general well-being!





- 11. Full Payment of the trip cost must be completed before the trip begins. Pending Payments may eventually lead to the cancellation of the trip.
- 12. The IDs shall all be verified before boarding. No boarding shall be entertained without a valid Govt. ID.
- 13. The Transfer of the bookings is not permitted. Only the names mentioned at the time of confirmation shall be allowed to travel.
- 14. No refunds shall be made towards any inclusion(s) not availed by the Client.
- **15.** Travelers must take care of their luggage & belongings. The management shall not be responsible for any damage or any missing items along the tour.
- **16.** The Air Conditioning will be switched off in the hills. Also, during the trip, it shall be the Driver's discretion to put off the AC as & when required, considering the travelers' safety & ease of travel along uneven & dangerous routes.
- 17. Our time of departure is fixed must depart by the stated time & keep their status updated with the trip coordinator(s). Anyone missing the bus shall not be eligible for any refunds. We shall call you twice before the schedule departure.
- 18. Drinking & Smoking are strictly prohibited along the tour due to health & safety concerns.
- 19. Trip With Nomads is a modern travel community, that organizes and arranges the adventure trip to the mountains which has the risk of accidents, loss of life, bodily injury, financial repercussions, etc. Neither the TWN nor its agents or affiliated entities shall be responsible or liable for any accident, bodily injury, illness or death, loss, or damage to baggage or property, or for any damages or claims whatsoever arising from loss (including loss of possessions and loss of enjoyment)
- **20.** TWN shall not be responsible for any delays or alterations in the program or indirectly incurred expenses in cases such as Natural Hazards, accidents, breakdown of machinery, weather conditions, landslides, political closure, or any untoward incidents.
- 21. In case of injury/illness occurring to a participant during the tour, external evacuation/transport services may need to be engaged safeguarding the health of the participant. In such a case any additional cost arising from making such arrangements will have to be borne by the concerned participant/participant's family.
- **22.** We do not provide any insurance policy to cover for the expenditure on sickness or accidents or losses incurred due to theft or other reasons.





1. Is Spiti open in winter (Oct-Feb)?

Yes, Spiti is accessible during these months but only via the Shimla-Kinnaur route. The Manali route closes after heavy snowfall at Rohtang & Kunzum Pass (usually by late September/early October).

2. How cold does it get in Spiti during winter?

Temperatures can drop to -20°C or lower in peak winter (Dec–Feb). October–November are relatively milder (0°C to -10°C).

3. Will we see snow during the trip?

Yes! From late October onwards, expect snow in Kaza, Kibber, Langza, Hikkim, and nearby villages. Roads often get snow-covered in Jan–Feb.

4. Is it safe to travel to Spiti in winter?

It's safe if you're traveling with an experienced group/organizer. Roads may get slippery, but local drivers are skilled for winter terrain. We avoid risky night drives.

5. Can beginners join a winter Spiti trip?

Yes, but be prepared for extreme cold. Basic fitness and mental readiness are important since weather conditions can get harsh.

6. What kind of stay is provided in winter?

Mostly heated homestays or guesthouses with traditional wood/coal stoves (bukhari). Hotels in Kaza remain closed after October. Staying with locals is the highlight!

7. What should I pack for a winter Spiti trip?

- Heavy winter jacket
- Thermal inners
- Woolen caps, gloves, muffler
- Waterproof snow boots
- · Lip balm, moisturizer, sunglasses
- · Power banks (electricity can be limited)

8. Will there be network & internet in Spiti during winter?

Only Airtel & Jio works in most villages. Internet is very weak and sometimes unavailable in peak winters.

9. What about washrooms & water in winter?

Due to freezing pipes, many homestays provide dry pit toilets. Warm water for bathing is limited, usually bucket-based.

10. Is AMS (Altitude Mountain Sickness) a concern in winter?

Yes, since Spiti is above 10,000 ft. Staying hydrated, eating light, and acclimatizing in Shimla/Recong Peo before heading up helps.





FAQs

11. Which months are best for winter Spiti trips?

- · October-November: Clear skies, less harsh cold, beautiful landscapes.
- December-February: Extreme snow, frozen rivers, high chances of spotting snow leopards & wildlife.

12. Can elderly people or kids join winter trips?

It's not recommended for children under 10 or elderly with health issues, due to extreme cold and high altitude.

13. Are all Spiti villages accessible in winter?

Yes, most villages like Kaza, Kibber, Langza, Hikkim, Komic remain open, but roads can temporarily close after heavy snowfall. Remote treks (like Pin Valley) are not accessible.


14. Can we see the famous Snow Leopard in winter?


Yes! Jan-Feb is the best time for snow leopard spotting around Kibber & Pin Valley with local trackers. And it all depend on your luck.

15. How many days are required for a winter Spiti trip?

A minimum of 7–9 days from Delhi/Chandigarh. Shorter trips are not advised due to long travel time and acclimatization needs.
